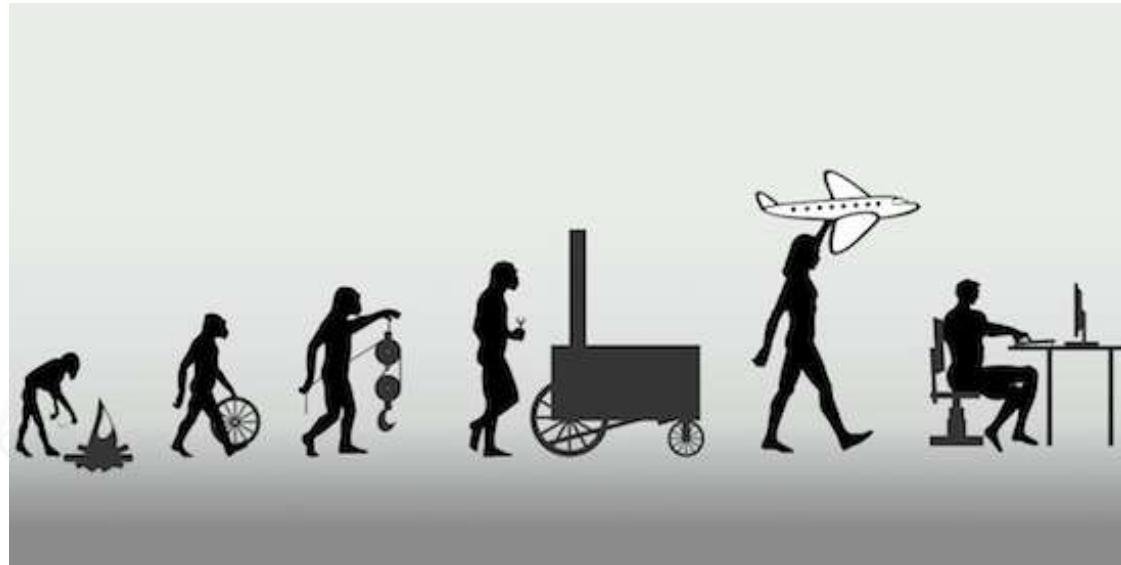

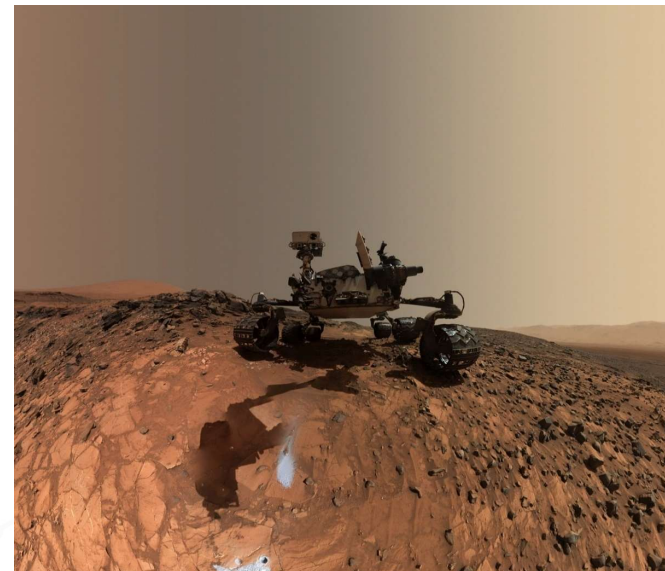

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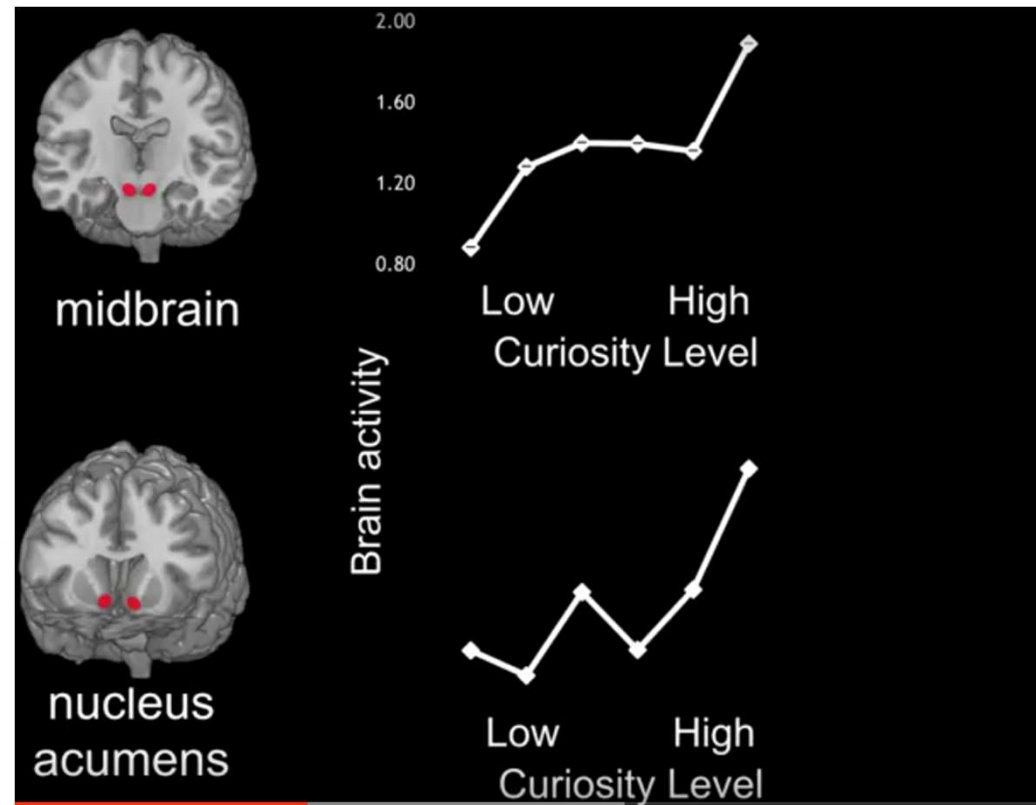
Curiosity is Following Quest-ions

A Curious Mind is a Hungry Mind

- Curiosity delivers a dopamine rush.
- Dopamine = pleasure
Eating chocolate, having good sex, winning at gambling, nicotine rush.
- We learn better, and remember more, when we're curious.
- Dopamine associated with motivation to discover.

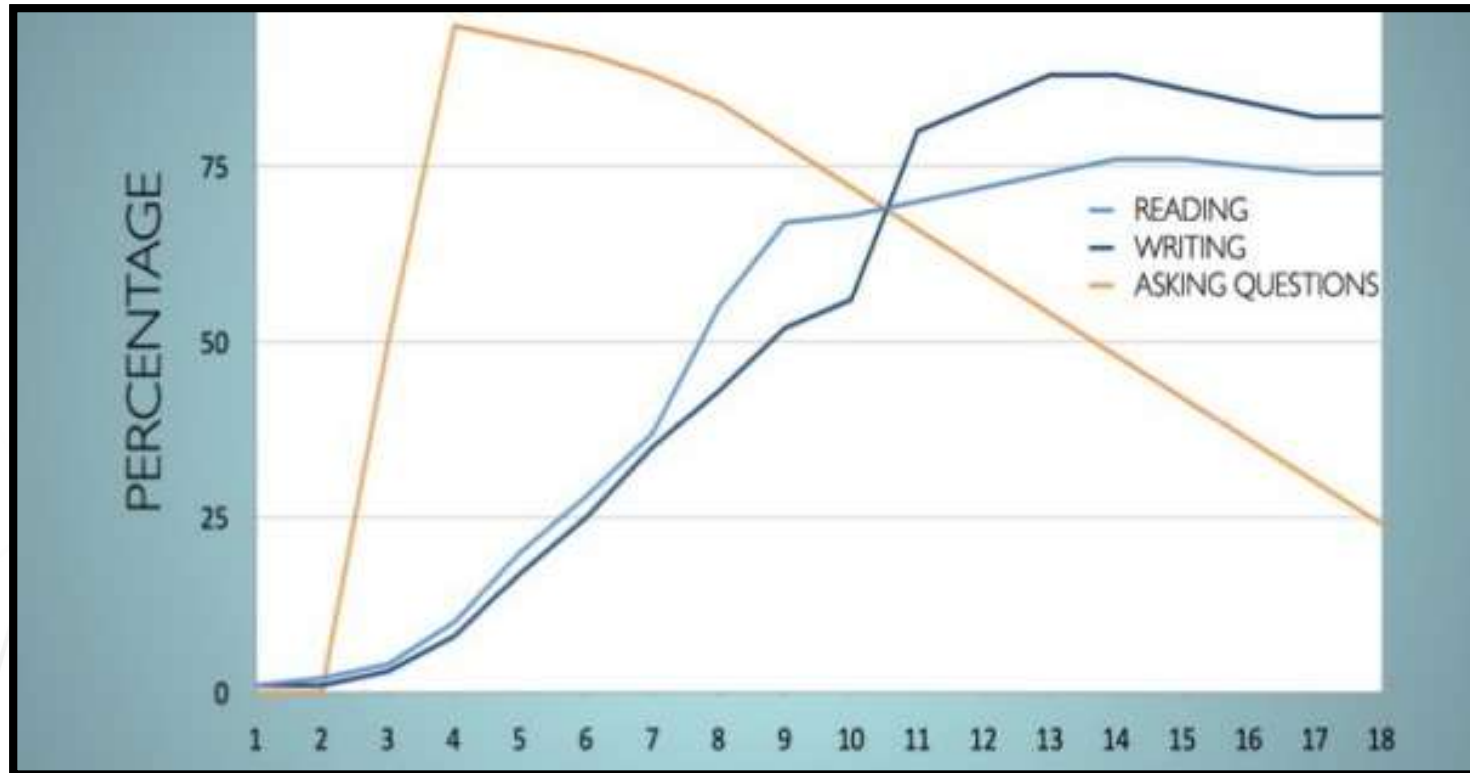


Curiosity is ...

- Curiosity enabled a physically feeble species with an extremely vulnerable infancy to dominate.

How do you ...?

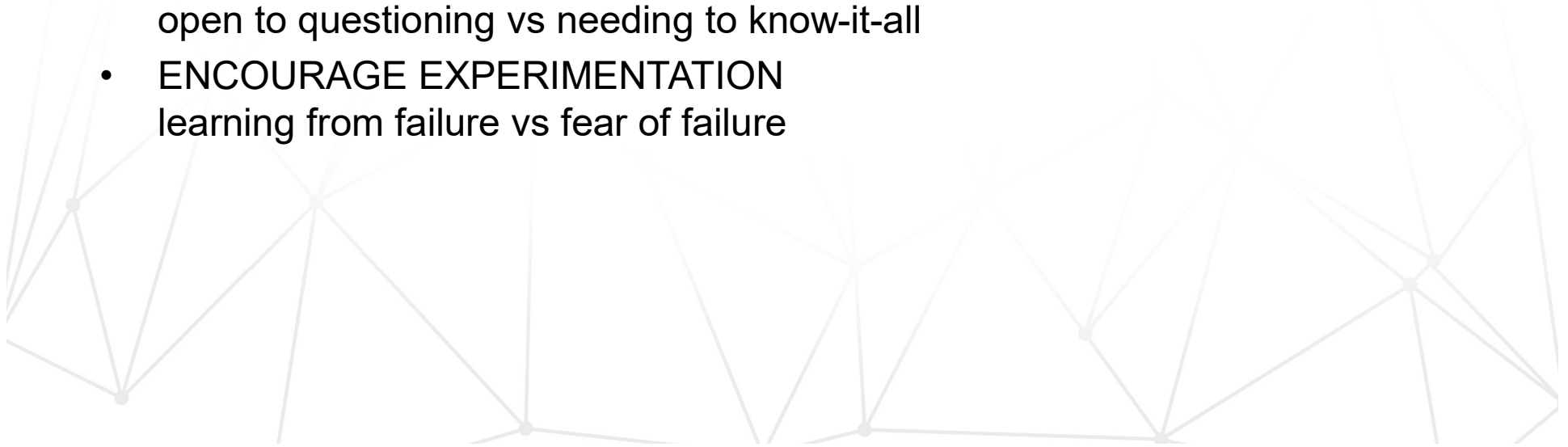
- Cultivate opportunities for discovery.

Cultivating a Curious Culture

- **BUILD CONFIDENCE**
sense of security enables curiosity vs fear/trauma shuts it down
- **ENCOURAGE INQUIRY**
encourage & follow questions vs have the right answer
- **GROW MINDFULNESS**
non-judgemental, open-minded vs 'mindless' (preconceptions, stereotypes, habit, orthodoxy)

Cultivating a Curious Culture

- **ENCOURAGE ACTIVISM**
engaged & pro-active vs passive & conforming
- **TRANSPARENCY**
open to questioning vs needing to know-it-all
- **ENCOURAGE EXPERIMENTATION**
learning from failure vs fear of failure

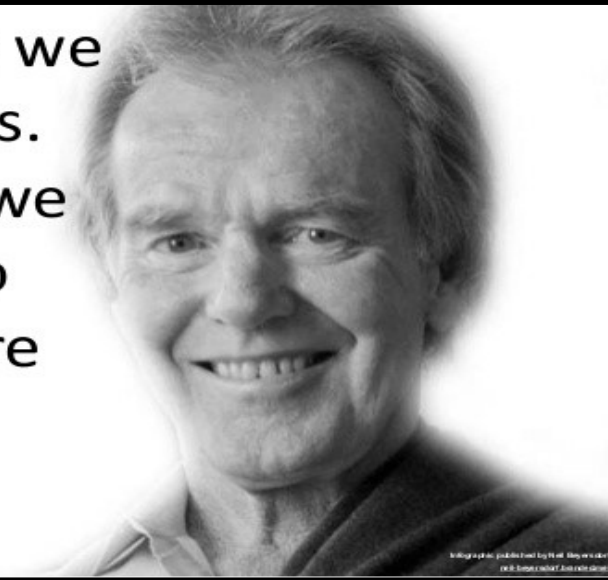
